For almost 4 years now, Joel, Joyce, and their 3 children, have been in Monument Valley, Utah, working on the Navajo Nation to raise up a team of medical missionary workers who are equipped to help their own native people. Natural remedies have truly been the right arm in reaching the traditional people. Joella Meyer will be managing the Health & Healing Center, which is nearing completion. They have already had precious experiences giving treatments from their home. Joyce teaches 1st & 2nd grades in the elementary school, and Joanna teaches cello. Mark does the website for the mission as well as helps his dad with hay sales, and whatever is needed.

ANN-MARIE SCOTT

was born in Jamaica and spent part of her childhood there, and part in New York City. She is a Registered Nurse and became interested in Lifestyle Medicine during her

college years after reading the book The Ministry of Healing. Currently, she works at "Wellness Secrets" in Arkansas, USA. They operate a lifestyle center which offers a 5 Day Live-in Program, where guests come with major lifestyle diseases, like diabetes, high blood pressure, and obesity. The guests follow a simple whole foods plant based diet, exercise, and follow some other basic principles of health, along with hydrotherapy. Ann-Marie has also worked at other health centers, including Uchee Pines Institute with Dr. Agatha Thrash, as well as at Hartland Institute.

KAI MESTER



spent the main part of his childhood in Upper Bavaria and in the Odenwald. After school, from 1990-1995, he completed his master studies in oriental languages, Islamic

and Jewish studies.

Since 1996, he works as editor of the magazine of hoffnung weltweit (Fundament/Versöhnngstag). He and his wife Bettina have three children: Jamila (16), Shireen (12) and Jaron (5).
